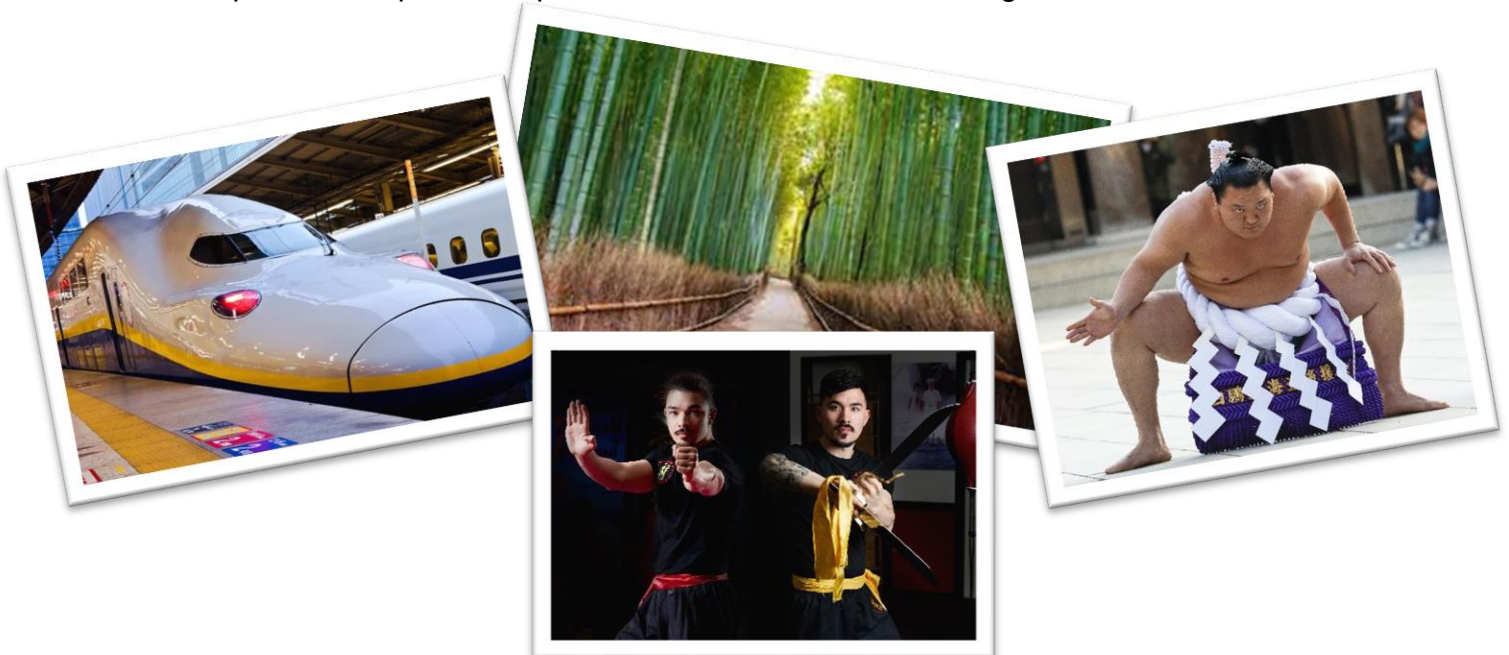
2023 JAPAN KUNG FU TOUR

Tokyo – Mt Fuji Region

Breakfast in hotel and check out.

Visit a half day sumo tournament.

Enjoy a chanko hotpot lunch (Japanese sumo stew).

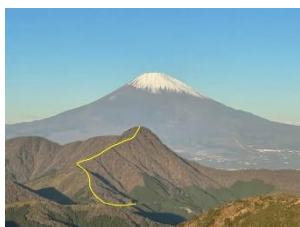
Travel to Hakone region by bus.

Dinner – a traditional kaiseki dinner.

Check into a traditional ryokan (hotel) – Hakone Kowakien TEN-YU (or similar).

Enjoy the Japanese baths.

Day 4 Monday Sept 18



Mt Fuji Region – Odawara - Kyoto

Breakfast and check out.

Travel to Mt Kintoki hike entrance by bus.

Hike Mt Kintoki (Ashigara) in Hakone and enjoy breathtaking views.

Ascend from Kintoki Shrine and descend via the Otome Pass.

Visit Teahouse on the mountain summit.

For people not wishing to hike, enjoy hotel facilities until check-out, or visit Okada Museum of Art next to hotel (extra charge).

Both groups meet up and travel to Odawara Station by bus.

Take the bullet train and enjoy a delicious train bento lunch on the way to Kyoto.

Transfer to hotel by bus.

Check into Okura Kyoto Hotel (or similar).

Dinner with Maiko, apprentice of Geisha performance.
Return to Okura Kyoto Hotel.

Thursday Sept 21



Kyoto - Nara

Breakfast.
Travel by bus to Nara and visit Todaiji Temple.
Visit adjacent Nara Park and feed the deer.
Lunch.
Check into the world first and only temple hotel at Nara, WAQOO Horyuji Temple Hotel (or similar).
Farewell authentic kaiseki dinner at hotel.

Day 8 - Departure
Friday Sept 22

Nara – Osaka – Home Country or Hong Kong option

One hour training in conference room.
Shower and breakfast.
Transfer by bus to Osaka airport for flight to home country.

Payment plan is available. Travel insurance is not included in the cost and must be taken out by the participant.

Cancellation

In order to give you the best possible rate for this tour, we book your hotels as soon as you make your booking. Therefore, in the event of cancellation we are obliged to charge the following:

The AUD\$600 deposit is non-refundable.

If you cancel between August 16 to 24, 2023 inclusive, the cancellation fee is 30% of the total tour fare.

If you cancel between August 25 to 31, 2023 inclusive, the cancellation fee is 50% of the total tour fare.

If you cancel between September 1 to 7, 2023 inclusive, the cancellation fee is 75% of the total tour fare.

From 7 days prior to departure the full trip cost is forfeited - NO REFUND.

This is why it is essential you take out travel insurance in case of personal emergency or sudden illness.

NO REFUNDS for voluntary termination of travel AFTER trip begins. If a member must involuntarily cancel for physical health reasons AFTER the trip has begun and does not use a portion of their already pre-paid services, NO refunds will be made. No refunds are made for unused excursions and special program activities.

The land price of the tour is fixed.

Travel Documents

All participants need a valid passport with at least (6) six months' validity remaining from date of departure.

Accommodation

Note that all hotel rooms are shared between 2 or 3 people.

Single Supplement

If you require a single room throughout the tour, add AUD\$665 (AUD\$95 per night).

All costs presume room share.

Room Share

Room sharing is on a *first come first served* basis. If the group number is uneven, the last person to book a shared room will be required to pay the single supplement (as above).

Itinerary

The organizers reserve the right to change/cancel itinerary, hotels, restaurants, services etc. nominated in tour itinerary should circumstances change. This would be for the best interest of the participants or any other operational reason.

Insurance
