TRIP INFORMATION AND BOOKING FORM

ITINERARY

Day 1 **Sat Sept 7**

Fly to Hong Kong. Transfer by bus to Salisbury Hotel in Kowloon for 5 nights.



Day 2 **Sun Sept 8**



Kowloon

Morning training in hotel studio or local park.
Breakfast in hotel.
Coach to Yip Man's grave in the New Territories to pay respects.
Coach to the Bruce Lee Heritage Museum at Sha Tin.
Own lunch at the nearby Newtown Plaza (with assorted food options).
Visit the nearby Ten Thousand Buddhas Monastery. (It takes about 20 minutes walking the trail from Pei Tau village)
If time permits, visit Kowloon Walled City Park on the way back to hotel.
Return by coach to hotel to refresh.
Welcome dinner at Serenade Chinese Restaurant, Tsim Sha Tsui.
After dinner, walk along the Avenue of Stars past the Clock Tower on the harbour.
Return to hotel.

Day 3 **Mon Sept 9**



Kowloon

Morning training in hotel studio or local park.
Breakfast in hotel.
Visit Victoria Peak, Repulse Bay and Stanley Market.
Western lunch at Stanley Market.
Return to hotel by coach to refresh.
Dinner at Grandmaster's favourite Chiuchow Garden Restaurant in Star House.
Walk through Kowloon Park to the Temple Street Night Market (about 30 mins).
Return to hotel.



Day 4 **Tues Sept 10**



Kowloon

Morning training in hotel studio or local park.
Breakfast.
Visit Ocean Terminal or Elements for shopping.
Visit the Sky 100 observation tower (if clear weather).
Own lunch.
Browse Nathan Road, the main thoroughfare in Kowloon.
Transfer to North Point Pier by coach for 2 hour Bauhinia cruise departing at 7:30pm with buffet dinner on board.
Return to hotel.

Day 5
Wed Sept 11



Kowloon – Free day

Breakfast in hotel.

Free day to explore Kowloon, take the Star ferry across to Hong Kong Island to shop, or just rest!

Own lunch.

Own dinner.

Prepare for tomorrow's check out.

Day 6
Thurs Sept 12



Kowloon / Lantau Island

Morning training in hotel studio or local park.

Breakfast in hotel.

Check out of hotel and meet in hotel foyer for the coach trip to Lantau Island.

Take the cable car up to the Po Lin Monastery.

Vegetarian lunch at the Po Lin Monastery.

Visit the Big Buddha and climb the 268 steps to the top, the hall of the 10,000 Buddhas.

Check into Hotel at City Gate for 2 nights.

Dinner at local restaurant walking distance from hotel

Day 7
Fri Sept 13



Lantau Island

Early morning training at park near hotel.

Breakfast in hotel.

Option 1:

Coach to Pak Kung Au. Hike to Lantau Peak (6km, steep uphill, around 4 hours) ending at Ngong Ping Market (packed lunch).

Option 2:

Coach to either Cheung Sha Beach – the longest beach in Hong Kong, or Pui O Beach (Black Sand Beach) for sightseeing.

Visit the historic Tai O fishing village and take a boat ride through the waterways. (Extra charge of HK\$50)

Coach to Ngong Ping Market and rejoin hiking group.

Return to hotel to relax.

Farewell dinner at nearby restaurant.

Prepare for tomorrow's departure.

Lantau Island / International flight

Breakfast in hotel.

Transfer to airport for international flight home.

End of tour.

Cancellation

In order to give you the best possible rate for this tour we book your flights and hotels as soon as you make your booking. Therefore, in the event of cancellation we are obliged to charge the following to cover fees incurred:

The AUD\$600 deposit is non-refundable.

A fee totaling 50% of total tour cost will be retained if you cancel between June 1 and July 31, 2024.

If you cancel on or after August 1, 2024, the full trip cost is forfeited - NO REFUND. This is why it is essential you take out travel insurance in case of personal emergency or sudden illness.

NO REFUNDS for voluntary termination of travel AFTER trip begins. If a member must involuntarily cancel for physical health reasons AFTER the trip has begun and does not use a portion of their already pre-paid services, NO refunds will be made. No refunds are made for unused excursions and special program activities.

Travel Documents

Twin Share

Room sharing is on a *first come first served* basis. If the group number is uneven, the last person to book a shared room will be required to pay the single supplement (as above).
